

Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Once again we would be entering into a Lenten season and truly we have to prayerfully prepare ourselves for attaining

spiritual enlightenment . As we reflect on John 4: 16-26, Jesus is intentionally entering the Samaritan town is a bold step towards ending race prejudice. This Samaritan woman was despised and ostracised due to her race, gender and even her identity was non-existent to the society .Indeed this well was the only place which gave her solitude and comfort. She has lost all hope and had no interest in life, in such situations God intervenes not to provide alternatives but new possibilities. When God is on our side we can start afresh. In Jn 4: 21 -22 Jesus deconstructs her religious perspective and conveys that God could not be limited to one place, by one nation or by one group of people and Jesus says that we should Worship the God in truth and spirit that means humans should develop the quality of holiness and build a true relationship with God. It will remove the ignorance and open our hearts to receive the life giving water. The Lord is not at all interested in outward expressions but examines the sacrifice of heart and internal attitude of submission.
