

# From the Vicar's Desk ....



Beloved in Christ,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ.

When E. Stanley Jones, well-known missionary to India, had the opportunity to meet with Mahatma Gandhi, he asked

India's revered leader a searching question: "How can Christianity make a stronger impact on your country?" Gandhi very thoughtfully replied that three things would be required.

First, Christians must begin to live more like Jesus. Second, the Christian faith should be presented without any adulteration. Third, Christians should emphasize love, which is at the heart of the gospel.

These insightful suggestions are the key to effective evangelism around the world. As messengers of God's love, we are to be human mirrors who reflect without distortion a growing likeness to our Lord; we are not to walk in "craftiness" (2 Cor. 4:2). If our lives reflect an image that is spiritually blurred, the truth of saving grace may not be clearly communicated (vv.3-5). We are also to share the biblical essentials of our faith clearly. We must not handle the Word of God "deceitfully" (v.2). And our lives are to be marked by love for God and others (1 John 5:1-2).

Let's be sure that we reflect a clear image of Jesus' likeness, the truth of God, and love.

In the month of August Kerala faced a terrible crisis of natural calamities. We forgot to safeguard our God-given Nature and its environment. Instead we exploited it to the hilt and criminally violated the first rule to tend and keep the land. Madhav Gadgil, well-known ecologist, submitted a report six years ago to the Central and state Governments regarding the great urgency to protect the fragile hilly regions of the Western Ghats. He suggested several steps for immediate implementation such as stoppage

of rock quarrying, red soil mining etc. in this area. But there arose strong protests against the 'Gadgil Report', including from the Churches there. Finally, we ignored the report and the warnings. As a result of the exploitation of the affluent society the poor people are suffering now.

In the month of September we are celebrating the 1st Sunday as Education Sunday. Teachers: To be filled with divine Wisdom is the main theme and our teachers will lead the service on that Sunday. Sevika Sangam Day will be celebrated on the 2nd Sunday with the Theme, Women: Equal participation in the Ministry of the Kingdom of God. Third Sunday is Senior Citizens Sunday. Honouring the Elder Generation is our Theme for that day. In the remaining Sundays of the month we will be discussing two important Sacraments namely Sacrament of Confession and the Sacrament of Anointing the Sick. Forgiveness of Sins and Healing the sick are the main motto of these Sacraments. May God enable us to study and mediate on the above themes for the enrichment of our Faith.

On September 13th is our Family get- together which is named as Sargolsavam. Our Sargolsavam committee is planning to celebrate the day to make it a memorable one.

Rev. P. C. James, Vicar of Thambaram (Chennai) parish is coming for the Diocesan collection. Every year we donate this money for sponsoring the less privileged children in the Mission fields of our Chennai-Bangalore Diocese. Rs. 25000/- is needed for the education of a student per year. Kindly contribute generously for the upliftment of the down trodden.

May God help us all to reach the expectation of His will as a Parish in the days to come.

# I Know I Can

Ephesians 3:14-21

[God] is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us. (Eph 3:20)

Remember the story of The Little Engine That Could? That determined little train climbed the steep hill by chanting positively, "I think I can. I think I can." And then, as it gained more resolve, it declared, "I know I can. I know I can."

No one would disagree that followers of Christ should think and live in a positive way. But do you ever find yourself depending too much on your own abilities rather than on the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit?

In John 15, Jesus explained our need for complete dependence on Him when He said, "He who abides in me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without me you can do nothing" (v.5). Paul reminded us that we "can do all things through Christ who strengthens [us]" (Phil. 4:13), that "the

excellence of the power [is] of God and not of us" (2 Cor. 4:7), and that we are "strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man" (Eph. 3:16).

Because of God's power, we can do whatever He asks of us - through Him. We can base our confidence not in our own abilities, but in God's absolute promises.

So, this month, with exceedingly more power than the little engine could ever muster, we can say, "I know I can. I know I can - because of Jesus."
